

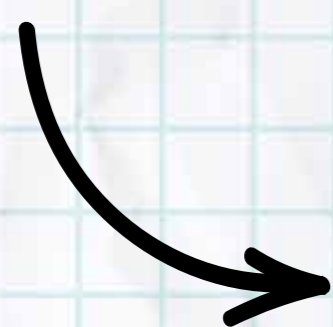
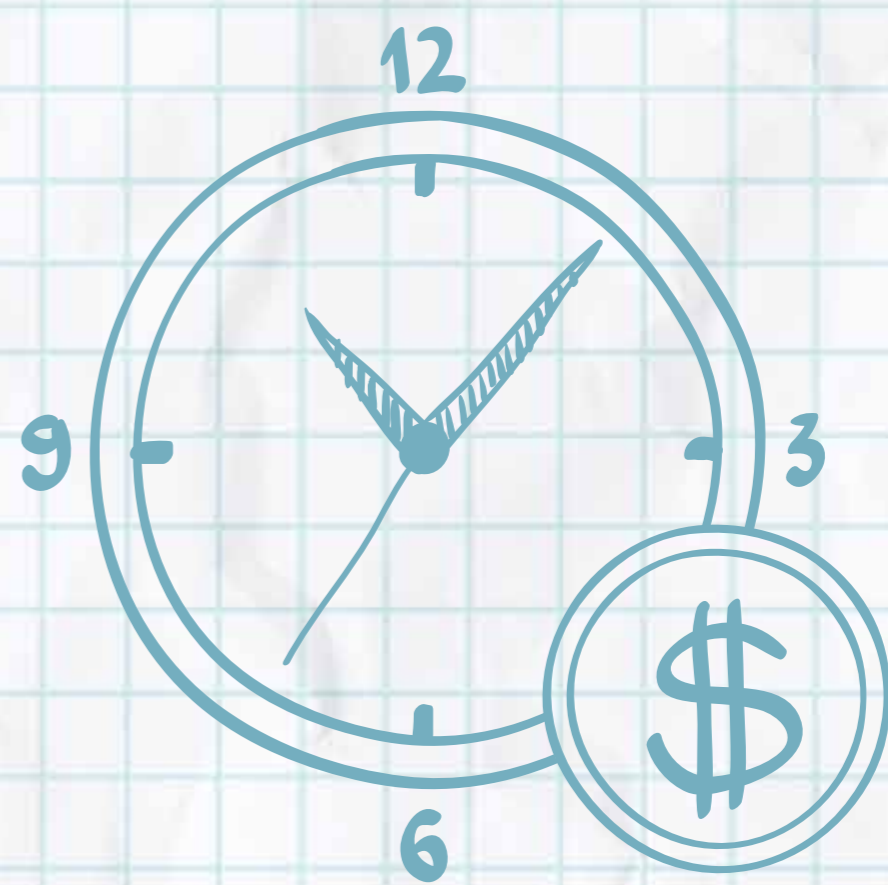
How do I climb the corporate ladder?

1. Take stock of my career

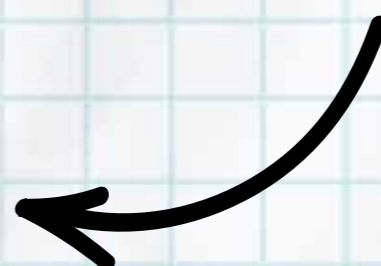
○ What do I bring to my company?

3. Request feedback from managers (and work on it!)

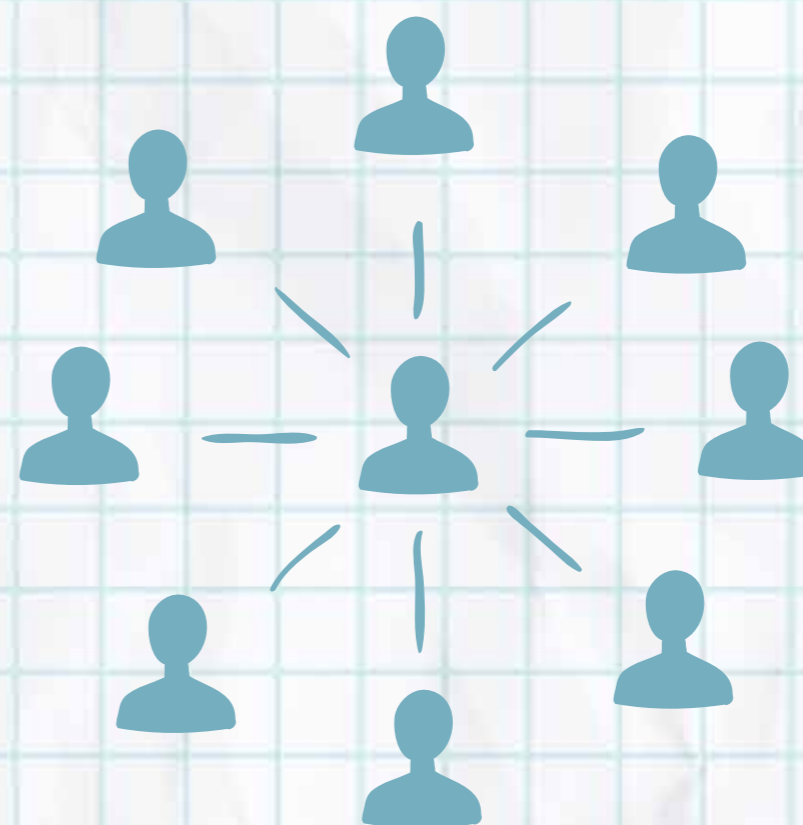
4. Network, network, network
