- 2 Expert Tip: Highlight your value proposition in your letter or e-note. This email might be shared with a prospective employer, so provide compelling details that make them want to speak with you.
- her strengths, Catherine smartly mentions her desire to understand how they may be useful in relation to the employer's needs. This is a brief, but powerful statement that shows she is focused on what's in it for them.
